ABOUT THE TRIP

The trip starts and ends in Nerja, the pearl by the sea at the foot of the mountains, seventy kilometres east of Málaga airport. Participants are responsible for their own transport between the airport and Nerja, both ways, we are happy to help with advice and tips.

The target group is motorcyclists who want to become better riders on both gravel and asphalt. We coach, instruct and give personal feedback. For the most part we avoid the busiest motorcycle roads and give you tips and advice on how to ride up and down mountainsides on small winding asphalt and gravel roads as well as some riverbeds (depending on water levels). Parts of the route become fairly advanced gravel riding for those who want it. After the trip you will have taken your riding to a new level and ridden Europe's best adventure roads.

We ride in a small group of eight participants with two instructors who also act as guides, which keeps the atmosphere close-knit and gives every rider more out of the trip.

THE RIDING

The daily distance is around 200–250 km. We set off after breakfast at around 09:00 and are back around 17:00–18:00. It only takes a few minutes from the house to where the fun roads begin, we avoid the traffic chaos of the city.

We stay mostly in and around the Sierras de Tejeda, Almijara y Alhama National Park, apart from during the special excursion to the Gorafe desert and Sierra Nevada. The area offers varied terrain, but it is the mountains that dominate.

During the days we pass groves of olives, mangoes, avocados and almonds, ride through warm fragrant pine forests and explore riverbeds with the occasional water crossing. There are opportunities for photography and fine viewpoints in many places. The road split is roughly 60 percent asphalt and 40 percent gravel.

We do not have completely fixed routes, the riding is adapted to the participants' level and wishes as well as energy and weather. Expect to ride a whole summer season's worth of curves in six days. We blend the training with fantastic roads and natural scenery.

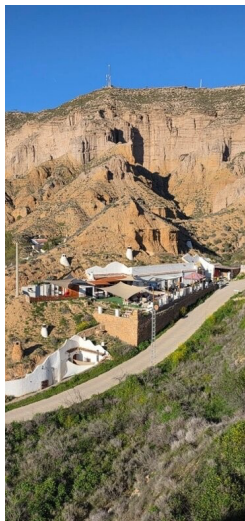


We move beyond the tourist-heavy roads, often on terrain you'll remember for a long time.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

We rent a house with a pool and roof terrace in Nerja as our base for the excursions. During the special excursion to the Gorafe desert we spend two nights at a picturesque cave hotel, for the authentic experience.

Breakfast is self-service at the house. Dinner is decided day by day depending on how everyone is feeling, a restaurant visit, catering, or something simple and good on the spot. Lunch is at a nice restaurant along the way, with a coffee break in the afternoon. The bikes are parked outside.



DRIVER TRAINING

Driver training is a central part of this trip. Develop your riding skills with the help of our certified instructors. The driver training is given as personal coaching and instruction according to certified methodology.

THE MOTORCYCLES

Everyone rides the Aprilia Tuareg 660, a mid-size adventure bike that is a perfect fit for this type of riding.

THE CLIMATE

When autumn, winter and spring are at their worst in Sweden, the weather is fantastic for motorcycle riding on the Costa del Sol. Expect roughly a Swedish summer, sometimes warm, sometimes a bit chilly at high altitude, and possibly the occasional rain shower. Adapt your riding gear accordingly.

PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY

- Valid driving licence, and passport and/or national ID card.
- Valid travel insurance, check your travel cover and cancellation insurance. An additional add-on for motorcycle gear transport and excess waiver on the motorcycle rental, for example ERV Bas, a couple of hundred SEK per week, can be a good complement to the travel cover in your home insurance.
- European Health Insurance Card, ordered from your national health insurance office.
- A deposit is reserved on your credit card when you collect the motorcycle, normally €1,500.
- Your own motorcycle gear. Keep in mind that it can get both warm and chilly, sometimes on the same day.

INCLUDED IN THE BASE PRICE

- Two Swedish guides who are also certified instructors with good local knowledge, plus certified driver training that takes your riding to a new level.
- Eight breakfasts, breakfast buffet at the rented house.
- Accommodation in a rented house in typical Spanish style, two triple rooms with single beds and two double rooms.
- Rental motorcycle for six days, delivered to Nerja.
- Guiding for six full riding days on the best roads in the area.
- Two hotel nights including breakfast in Gorafe.

NOT INCLUDED

- Flights to and from Málaga, book in consultation with the guide.
- Transit to and from the airport, Málaga–Nerja return.
- Meals beyond breakfast.
- Travel insurance.
- Personal protective equipment and helmet.
- Excess waiver, can be purchased at a good price through ERV.
- Fuel.
- Other insurance and personal expenses.
